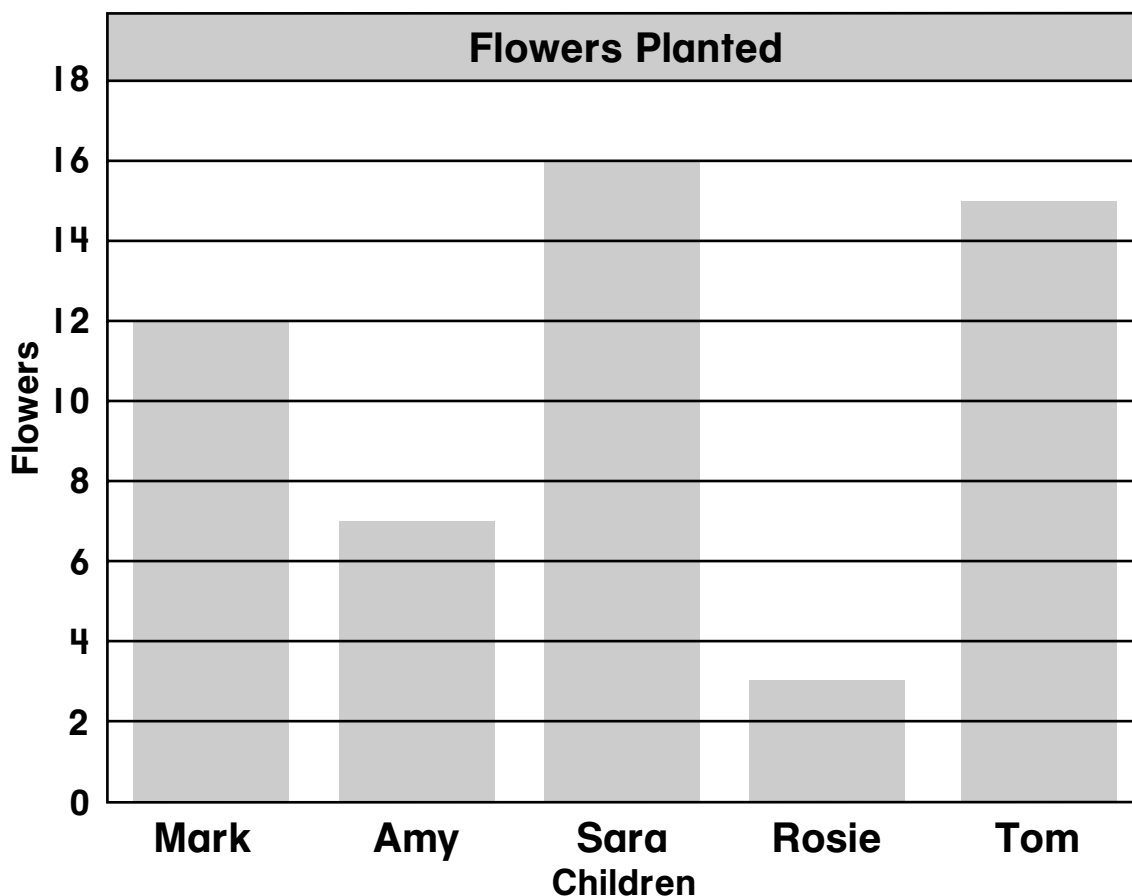


Counting Flowers
